- Interested in serving and leading students (preferably already demonstrating this interest through involvement in some type of student ministry).
- Willing and able to be an example in your Christian walk.

Staff Positions Available

Staff

Team Leader	Responsible for students on team, team discussions, team study, counseling, mentoring, team sports, and kitchen duties.
Room Counselor	Responsible for students in your room, evening devotions, direct room clean-up, make sure rules are followed.
Other Duties	General running of camp and various activities, may be called upon to help with some teaching responsibilities.
Staff Orientation	You will need to arrive early for staff orientation (Camp 1—6/13/2010; Camp 2—6/24/2010) You MUST have your study completed before you arrive for orientation.

Support Staff

Team Assistant	Assigned to various teams to aid staff and to learn how to lead a team.
Kitchen Staff	Assist kitchen staff with the serving and clean-up of meals by directing teams during their kitchen duty.
Sports	Set-up and clean-up, officiate, keep track of and post sporting event outcomes.
Room Counselor	Responsible for students in your room, lead evening devotions, direct room clean-up, make sure rules are followed.
Staff Orientation	You will need to arrive early for staff orientation (Camp 1—6/13/2010; Camp 2—6/24/2010) You MUST have your study completed before you arrive for orientation.

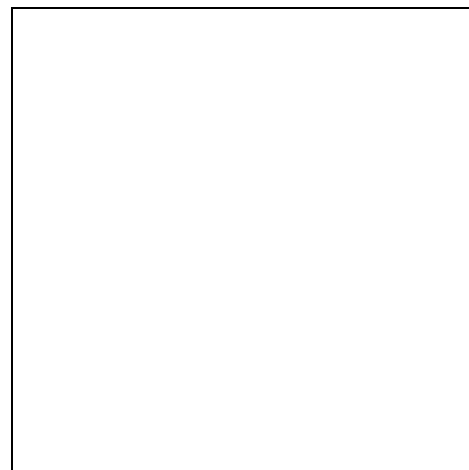
